









Casting/Streaming Update

By December 31, 2024:

- ➤ 2 popular streaming apps are required on guestroom TVs*.
- Linear version of HBO or Showtime (delivered via satellite or cable) may count as one of the two required streaming apps.
- Casting is optional and no longer required.
- *NOTE: Streaming should not be provided on any public space TVs (Fitness Room, Lobby, Breakfast Area, etc.)



Casting and Streaming Explained

Let's use a scenario where we have a checked-in guest who wants to watch a Netflix movie on their guestroom TV.

Below are 2 examples that outline the difference between casting and streaming.

- **Casting** is when the guest signs into the app on their mobile device (cell phone, tablet, or laptop) to send the movie to the guestroom TV.
- **Streaming** is when the guest signs into the app on the guestroom TV to watch the movie.
- NOTE: Streaming can be done on a <u>Smart</u>
 <u>TV Or a non-Smart TV</u> with a box attached to it.



Questions to ask your current TV content provider/prospective streaming vendors:

- Can they offer you a cost-effective streaming solution that offers guests two popular streaming applications?
- Will their streaming solution work with your current TVs (if your TVs are compliant with the new standard)?
- If you need to purchase new TVs, can they recommend TV models that are compatible with their streaming hardware to ensure a smooth guest streaming experience?
- Can they provide recommendations for internet bandwidth speed, signal strength, number of access points, and Wi-Fi Version to support a smooth guest streaming experience?
- What is required so the equipment can properly connect? Example, VLAN requirements, as well as a managed switch?
- Does their streaming solution interface with the property's PMS system to wipe the guest's user credentials upon checkout for apps such as Netflix?



50" Television Requirement

By December 31, 2024, all Best Western branded hotels are required to comply with the following Television Guidelines:

- Guestrooms: 50" Television(s) with streaming*
- Lobby and Breakfast Area: 50" Television
- Fitness Area: 50" Television
- All TVs must be commercial, hospitality grade
- * Streaming should not be provided on any public space TVs (Fitness Room, Lobby, Breakfast Area, etc.)
- ➤ Televisions will be considered compliant until seven (7) years after the original date of manufacture by which time they must be replaced with a television that meets these Television Guidelines





- Commercial, hospitality-grade TVs are required.
- NOTE: It is recommended that properties meet with their TV Content provider & streaming provider to ensure that the TVs they wish to purchase are compatible with their hardware.

- Are the TVs compliant with the TV Ballot 50" TV/Streaming standard?
- Will the TVs you are considering support the streaming solution you intend to use?
- Will the TVs you are considering be compatible with the streaming solution hardware (remotes, etc.) to ensure a smooth, hassle-free guest streaming experience?

- It is very important that properties
 ensure they have adequate internet
 bandwidth speed, signal strength, and
 wireless access points to accommodate
 the new streaming requirement.
- BWH Hotels offers an HSIA Advocate team to assist with any installation or support questions. The team can help to define the appropriate HSIA solution for the hotel and coordinate the installation with an endorsed vendor and works on behalf of the hotel to ensure that solutions will meet the guest expectations.

Bandwidth Recommendations

Hotels shall provide their guests with shared bandwidth, using the following formula to determine minimum capacity for the entire guest HSIA network:

- ✓ Download: Hotel guest room count multiplied by 4 Mbps
- ✓ Upload: Hotel guest room count multiplied by 2 Mbps.
- ✓ Example: A 100-room hotel should have 400 Mbps download at minimum.

NOTE: These are recommendations only. Hotels may need more based on their local market and customer demand.



Questions to ask HSIA vendors

- Does my current internet infrastructure need to be upgraded to support a smooth guest streaming experience?
- Do I have sufficient internet bandwidth speed and signal strength to support a smooth guest streaming experience?
- Do I have sufficient wireless access points to support a smooth guest streaming experience?
